




Situation of 13 April 2022 edition of the hours 14-next update 15-04-2022 hours 14, forecaster: GA


Slightly cloudy skies with haze at high altitudes, some local cloud cover, and mildtemperatures.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: The snow cover in the morning is mainly consolidated and characterized by superficial snowcrusts from melting and freezing, also rather hard on strongly wind-blown ridges. Very warmtemperatures during the day. With the daytime heat and sun on very steep slopes and walls, starting from slopes exposed to the east, in extension to the south and west, which are stillsnow covered up to the north, especially under approximately 2000 m, chance of an increasein natural, damp- or wet-snow avalanches, mainly small and medium in size. Avalanchedanger this afternoon is 2 (moderate) on the Alps and in the Canin above 1800 m, 1 (low)below this altitude and on the Prealps.

Forecast for Thursday 14 April 2022, reliability: 80%


Generally favorable conditions in the morning. Wet-snow avalanches throughout the day.

Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:

Clear skies, hazy at times. Warm at high altitudes.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Generally clear skies. Freezing point will be at 3400 m, with very warm temperatures. Thesnow cover will undergo a slight reduction in thickness and will gradually tend to disappear onsouthern slopes, typical of springtime. Until the early morning, the snow cover will be generallystable. With the daytime heat and sun during the morning on very steep slopes and from walls, chance of an increases of wet-snow avalanches, mainly small and medium in size, bothnatural and triggered, even with the passage of skiers and hikers. This will start from slopesexposed to the east, in extension to the south and west, which are still snow covered up to thenorth, especially below 2200 m. Avalanche danger will be 1 (low) the morning throughout theterritory, increasing to 2 (moderate) during the morning on the Alps and in the Canin areaabove approximately 1800 m.









Generally favorable conditions in the morning. Wet-snow avalanches throughout the day.







Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG: Clear in the morning, variable to cloudy in the afternoon, with chance of light rain.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Cloudy in the morning and overcast in the afternoon with light rain. Freezing point at 2800 m. The snow cover in the early morning will be generally consolidated. With the daytime heat andsun in the morning, and the chance of light rain in the afternoon on very steep slopes and fromwalls, chance of an in increases of wet -snow avalanches, generally small and medium in size, both natural and triggered, even with the passage of skiers and hikers. Avalanche danger will be 1 (low) in the morning throughout the territory, increasing to 2 (moderate) during themorning on the Alps and in the Canin area above approximately 1800 m.

Forecast for Saturday 16 April 2022, reliability: 80%

Generally favorable conditions in the morning. Wet-snow avalanches throughout the day.





Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG: Mostly sunny or slightly cloudy in the morning. Variable with some thunderstorms in theafternoon.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Generally variable skies with chance of thunderstorms . Freezing point at 2200 m. In themorning, the snow cover will be generally consolidated. During the day, with a rise intemperature, and due to the effect of the precipitations, even snowy at high altitudes, chanceof several natural damp-snow avalanches, generally small in size, on very steep slopes andfrom walls. Avalanche danger 1 (low) throughout the territory.
