




Situation of 20 April 2022 edition of the hours 14-next update 22-04-2022 hours 14, forecaster: MM


Slightly cloudy to variable skies with more consistent cloud cover over the Carnic Alps andPrealps.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: During the night, weak snowfall affected the mountain area, greater precipitation to East (5-10 cm) and weak or absent to the West. The snow cover is generally stable everywhere, and almost totallyabsent on southern slopes. The new snow has settled on the ground or on hard icy surfaces onslopes with the presence of old snow. In these areas, on very steep slopes, beware of the risk ofslipping, since the old snow may not be well bonded. Expected avalanche of danger is 1 (low)throughout. Chance of isolated fresh-snow avalanches with weak cohesion, especially from rockywalls and very steep slopes.

Forecast for Thursday 21 April 2022, reliability: 80%

Generally stable snowy cover. Beware of the possible presence of icy layers.

Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:

Slightly cloudy skies in the morning, then overcast.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Slight cloudy skies in the morning, variable in the afternoon. The snow cover is generally stableeverywhere, and almost totally absent on southern slopes. On snowy slopes, the surface is hard andicy, so beware of the risk of slipping, especially in areas with fresh snow, since the bond with theold snow may be poor. Expected valance danger will be 1 (low) everywhere. Chance of isolatedfresh-snow avalanches with weak cohesion, especially from rocky walls and very steep slopes, where snow has not yet detached. Under 2000 m, during the warmest hours of the day, chance of anincrease in natural avalanche activity with the formation of small wet- or damp-snow avalanches.





Forecast for Friday 22 April 2022, reliability: 70%


In the Canin area, avalanche danger increasing to 2 (moderate) during the day.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: From night to early afternoon, snowfall at above 1500 m. The expected precipitation will begenerally weak (5-10 cm), but more abundant in the Canin area (20 cm). On southern slopes, newsnow will largely settle on the ground while, on snowy slopes, it will settle on hard icy crusts. Wind may favor snow storms. On the Canin area, avalanche danger will be 1 (low), increasing to 2(moderate) during the day. On very steep northern slopes, generally over 2000 m, chance oftriggered small- and medium-sized avalanches on a local level, of even with a weak overload. Snowwith weak cohesion may detach from rock walls. Throughout the rest of the mountain territory, avalanche danger will be 1 (low) in consideration of the expected lesser amounts of snow.Throughout the territory, under 2000 m, small wet- or damp-snow avalanches are possible.

Forecast for Saturday 23 April 2022, reliability: 60%

In the Canin area, avalanche danger will be 2 (moderate), 1 (low) in the rest of the territory.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Some light rain in the afternoon, with snowfall above 2000 m. In the Canin area, avalanche dangerwill be 2 (moderate), 1 (low) throughout the rest of the territory 1.
